

<u>Demonstrations</u> may require an evaluation of outcomes in order to determine suitability for the full FDP. A <u>Demonstration</u> would normally involve at least one member institution and may involve a federal agency. All Demonstrations must be approved by the appropriate <u>Programmatic Committee Co-Chairs</u> and/or <u>Executive</u> Committee.

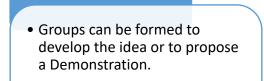
THE INITIATION, EVOLUTION, AND OVERSIGHT OF AN FDP DEMONSTRATION

Emerging Topic or Idea

- Discussions of topics and ideas can originate within
 <u>Programmatic Committees or</u>
 <u>Subcommittees</u> or be suggested to <u>Programmatic</u>
 <u>Committees</u> by any FDP member.
- Sessions and discussion groups can be held as needed initially, based on approval of <u>Programmatic Committee Co-Chairs</u>.
- Discussions can evolve into an FDP Demonstration Proposal.
- Goal of initial sessions or discussions should be to learn and discuss possible role or Demonstration for FDP related to the topic or idea.

Demonstrations

- <u>Demonstration</u> types include Exploratory Initiative, Study, White Paper, Tool or Guidance Document, Survey, or Pilot Project.
- Generally, as ideas formulate, they should be written up, shared, and discussed with <u>Programmatic Committee Co-Chairs</u> first, and then the <u>Executive Committee</u>. This is done by submitting a <u>FDP</u> <u>Demonstration Proposal</u>.
- Once the <u>FDP Demonstration</u> <u>Proposal</u> is reviewed and/or approved by the <u>Executive</u> <u>Committee</u>, information will be added to the online listing of <u>FDP Demonstrations</u> as well as the oversight <u>Programmatic</u> <u>Committee or Subcommittee</u> page.



Group Formation

- The <u>FDP Committee Structure</u>, <u>Scope and Authority</u> provides a matrix of group types.
- New Subcommittees, steering committees, and working groups can be formed through submission and approval of a <u>FDP Subcommittee, Steering</u> <u>Committee, Working Group</u> <u>Formation Request</u>.

Group Oversight & Management

- Group chairs/leaders and members should follow the guidelines found in the <u>FDP</u> <u>Committee Opportunities and</u> <u>Expectations</u>.
- Routine meetings and reporting up to the oversight <u>Programmatic Committee</u> are expected.
- A designated project manager and use of FDP-provided project management tools by groups are encouraged.
- A standalone group website and continuous outreach to the community provide transparency to group activities.
