

- ☐ Any inconsistencies with our award shall be resolved in the following order:
 - Federal statutes
 - Federal regulations
 - 2 CFR part 200, as modified and supplemented by DoD's interim implementation found in 2 CFR part 1103
 - Award-specific terms and conditions
 - DoD R & D General Terms and Conditions, July 2016





- ☐ Publicly Releasable Project Summary/Abstract
 - Be concise abstract -- 300 words or less submitted with proposal
 - Mark abstract "publically releasable"
 - Use terms the public can understand
 - Describe research objective, technical approach, anticipated outcome, and potential impact of the specific research





☐ If you receive an award, we MUST publish your abstract to a searchable website available to the general public in accordance with Public Law 113-235

PRE-AWARD COST

- ☐ Request in writing Grants Officer prior written approval if your research for pre-award costs
- ☐ See 2 CFR 200.308(d)(1) and 2 CFR 200.458, if more than ninety (90) days pre-award costs requested
- ☐ Document why pre-award costs are necessary and essential for the research proposed



REPORTING



- ☐ All AFOSR awards require at least annual and final technical performance reports
- ☐ Annual Performance Report = Program Manager & http://afosr.reports.sgizmo.com/s3/
- ☐ Final Performance Report, including SF 298 Report Documentation Page = Program Manager & http://afosr.reports.sgizmo.com/s3/

 - Issued July 1, 2016 Open until superseded

- □ BAA-AFRL-AFOSR-2015-0008 Air Force Defense Research Sciences Conference and Workshop Support
 - Issued July 22, 2016 August 1, 2017



AFOSR SOLICITATIONS



□BAA-AFRL-AFOSR-2016-0009- Military Medical Photonics Program

- Issued July 7, 2016 Closes October 31, 2016
- Broad-based research and development aimed at using lasers and other light source technology to develop applications in medicine, photobiology, surgery, and closely related materials sciences, with applications to combat casualty care and other military medical problems



AFOSR SOLICITATIONS



- ☐ Defense Multidisciplinary Research Program of the University Research Initiative (MURI)
 - Issued April 4, 2016 Closes November 5, 2016
- Focus is on multidisciplinary research effort where more than one traditional discipline interacts to provide rapid advances in scientific areas of interest to DOD
- Sponsored by DOD research offices ONR, ARO, and AFOSR



INTERNATIONAL STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM (ISEP)



- ☐ ISEP is a new opportunity from AFOSR Program Officers
 - AFOSR-funded Principal Investigator request to fund a graduate student the opportunity to work with a foreign collaborator for a short term
 - Foreign collaborator can send a graduate student to work with an stateside AFOSR-funded Principle Investigator for a short term



INTERNATIONAL STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM (ISEP)



- Not more than \$15,000 in additional funding per selected project
- ☐ The \$15,000 in additional funding will not be further supplemented to compensate for overhead and administrative costs
- ☐ New Proposal Submissions require a separate proposal accompanying original research proposal
- ☐ Previously funded grants submit new proposal to Program Office



REHABILITATION ACT OF 1973



- ☐ All AFOSR announcements will henceforth comply with the Rehabilitation Act of 1973
- ☐ The primary purpose is to provide access to and use of Federal executive agencies' electronic and information technology (EIT) by individuals with disabilities
- ☐ Complies with Section 508



COST SHARING



☐ AFORST DOES not require cost sharing for proposals

☐ Cost sharing is not an evaluation or selection criterion



Acknowledgement of Support and Disclaimer Requirements



- ☐ Air Force Grants require researchers to acknowledge support provided by the Government in all materials based on or developed under our awards.
- ☐ The requirement extends to copyrighted and non-copyrighted materials published or displayed in any medium.



Billing Timeliness



☐ Timely Billing Essential

- ☐ Late Billing jeopardizes:
 - Funding on present efforts
 - Awards of new grants
- ☐ Spending Rate Determines the Obligation Rate which Determines AFOSR Future Dollars
