- <u>Status of EPA Implementation of Government-wide DUNS/UEI Transition</u>
 - Revision Date: 11/16/2021
 - Effective May 17, 2021, informs recipients and applicants of the status of EPA's implementation of the Government-wide transition from using DUNS as a Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) to a SAM.gov created UEI.

- <u>Status of EPA Implementation of Government-wide DUNS/UEI Transition</u>
 - Until further notice, all EPA funding opportunities (competitive and non-competitive) will continue to use DUNS-compatible grant application packages and no change will be implemented at this time. Applicants will continue to use their DUNS number when completing forms in EPA grant application packages. The EPA application package, the contents of which is further described in RAIN-2018-G07-2, includes two forms that require a DUNS: the SF-424, Application for Federal Assistance and EPA Form 4700-4, Preaward Compliance Review Report for All Applicants and Recipients Requesting Federal Financial.


