Requirements

- Regulatory Language
- Acceptable to IRB personnel
- Useable by faculty/students
- Account for “it depends” situations



Goals

- Dual comparison of all exempt and expedited protocols
- Provide institutional results
- Provide explanation of discrepancies (if any)



Results

- 1,003 Paired studies (10/01/19-03/20/20)
- 5 Institutions
- 97% concordance
 - Wizard Ineligible given IRB non-exempt
 - 2 institutions, 4 studies each (8 of 294 Expedited)
- Low through put → 10%
 - Wizard Exempt given IRB Exempt
 - Effective exclusion testing
 - Overconservative features?
 - Continuing need for added clarity
