USDA Enterprise Solution for Grants Management

- Builds on and integrates with USDA's financial management system (FMMI)
- Approximately 10 USDA agencies using, designing, or exploring the use of the system

NIFA Release #1

- FY 2017 Capacity Awards will be processed through the system
- Applicants will continue to apply through Grants.gov and be paid through ASAP

What is next for applicants?

- Testing will start late winter/early spring
- Access to the external portal will require USDA eAuthentication level 2

 - Level 1 not required
 - One time action

- Actively pursing overdue reports 2010-present
 - 4 weeks to provide needed report
- Administratively closing 2009-prior awards

FY 2016 Budget

- AFRI up \$25M (\$350M)
- Food Safety Outreach up \$2.5M (\$5M)
- New Veterinary Svcs Grant Prog (\$2.5M)
- SARE program up \$2M (\$24.667M)
- Increases in Evans-Allen and 1890
 Extension to support additional 1890 inst
- Continues pre-2014 Farm bill matching requirements for AFRI

FY 2016 Budget – cont'd.

- Crop Protection and Pest Mgmt is under the Integrated program authority and the Act includes language exempting Extension IPM grant area from IDC.
- Supports most other programs at 2015 levels
- 30% IDC limit

- Felony and Tax certification

Update – Farm Bill Implementation

- Veterinary Services Grant Program
 - Newly-funded in FY 2016 at \$2.5m
 - Competitive grant program to develop, implement, and sustain veterinary services
 - Broad eligibility including for-profits and nonprofits, institutions with programs in veterinarian shortage situations
 - NIFA will be seeking public comment on implementation in the coming months

Update – Farm Bill Implementation

- Commodity Boards for AFRI (Section 7404)
 - Commodity boards were invited to propose topics for AFRIs RFA – 100% match required
 - 18 proposed topics were received by Sept. 22 from 12 Federal and State Commodity Boards
 - 7-9 topics will be incorporated in FY16 AFRI RFAs
- Centers of Excellence
 - awarded more than \$41.8 million to 34 projects
 - 156 of 1860 (8%) of applicants requested
 - had higher funding rates than overall pool
