2018 Policy Guide Update

- NIFA Federal Assistance Policy Guide July 2014
- NIFA began process to update Policy Guide in 2017
- Primary areas of update:
 - Uniform Guidance citations and changes
 - New statutory and regulatory changes
 - Capacity terms and conditions
 - Updated NIFA processes
 - Consistent Definitions
 - Discussion of Allowable costs
- Format change align with 2 CFR 200



Key Additions

- Enhanced Capacity grant section, including info from previous administrative manuals
- Enhanced definitions, bringing in definitions from 2 CFR 200, 7 CFR 3430, and the previous administrative manuals
- Allowable costs matrix and details, addressing FAQs and concerns
- Enhanced post award management section, including additional standards from Uniform Guidance
- Detail on areas requiring prior approval

- Complete update to Policy Guide (Est. May 2018)
- Conduct two webinars to obtain feedback

(Est. 3rd week of June 2018)

- Competitive awardees
- Capacity awardees
- Feedback due to NIFA: Est. End of July
- Edit based on feedback (Est. August 2018)
- Publish as final (Est. End of August 2018)

1890 and Insular area matching final rule

- Published in the Federal Register on May 11, 2018
 - Published as NPRM November 2017
 - No relevant comments submitted
- Amends 7 CFR 3419 by:
 - Making updates to definitions and language consistent with the past three Farm Bills (e.g., replacing the word "formula" with "capacity")
 - Finalizing the process by which 1890's and insular areas submit matching waivers. The process is consistent with the current process NIFA uses.
 - Removes the term qualifying education activities from the definitions and allowable uses.
 - Clarifies allowable uses of matching funds
