Navy ROTC Cyber Training Program

Upcoming Navy ROTC Cyber Training Program Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) to be released with a goal of:

- Providing solutions that will grow a capable and trained workforce with the skills to defend against emergent cyber and electronic warfare threats.
- Develop the research capability of and technical skills taught to university students (principally those enrolled in ROTC programs, but other students will also be welcome).
- Target Release date: June 2019 (estimate)



ONRs New Funding Approach for ONR Grants

- May 2018 CNR memo encourages funding research grants with initial increment for:
 - Twenty-four (24) months and annually thereafter,
 or
 - When working with P.I. without a proven track record, twelve (12) months and then a subsequent 24 month increment, if sufficient progress is demonstrated.
 - Transition to this model begins with FY19 grants
 - Subject to funding availability



Navy ePS Contract

- Contract for ePS awarded in March 2019.
- Award writing system that will create contracts, grants, cooperative agreements, and Other Transaction Agreements.
- Will interface with Grants.gov.
- Will create BAAs and FOAs.
- Limited deployment scheduled for Q3 of FY2020, full deployment by Q3 FY21.



Reminder on Navy Policy affecting Refunds under Navy Awards

- In January, ONR Grant & Cooperative Agreement T&Cs were revised to indicate a preference for submitting refunds electronically through pay.gov.
- ONR's plan is to update ONR T&Cs to require use of pay.gov for all refunds submitted under new awards issued on or after 01 OCT 2019.
- Gives awardees time to revise their processes to optimize use of electronic processes for refunds.
