

Estimated Time Taken Away from Research



Estimated time taken from research by non-research requirements was 2% higher than in our previous surveys, suggesting that workload associated with federally-funded research may be increasing.

Estimated Time Taken Away from Research

What steps can be taken to stop this trend of increasing requirement-related workload and to move in the opposite direction?



Estimated Time Taken Away from Research

(Proposed Hierarchy of Steps to Reduce Excess Pl Workload)

Identify unnecessary workload → **Goal: Eliminate**

(If it does not contribute to its intended purpose, offloading it to someone else or paying more in overhead to deal with it, is inefficient and wasteful for all parties.)

Identify needed but inefficient workload → **Goal:** Streamline


Identify needed, streamlined but <u>assignable</u> workload → Goal: <u>Re-assign</u>


How can stakeholders come to agree on which workload is unnecessary? inefficient? assignable? and what can be done about it?





Average Estimated Time Away Is Generally Lower at

Institutions with large research portfolios

Build portfolio/infrastructure??

Private institutions \rightarrow Enhance research focus/infrastructure??

Larger aver. faculty **research assignment** → Reduce teaching assignments??

Also

Fewer service/training/curriculum-related (and even applied) projects → Avoid these??

Less human/animal subjects research

Are there possible action items implied here?

→ One size often does not fit all

FDP: Bring similar institutions together to work within constraints

PI Climate Perception Correlates of Institution Time Away Averages


My institution...

... has a culture of trust in researchers.

...makes it straightforward to find answers about federal regulations related to research.

...effectively assists faculty with managing federally funded grants and contracts.

...effectively assists faculty with applying for federal grants and contracts.



Average Estimated Time Away Is Generally Lower at institutions with:

A strong **culture of trust** in researchers -> Goal: Strengthen Pl-admin rapport

Effective Research Administration -> Goal: Strengthen admin support of Pls

- Easy-to-find answers re: research-related requirements
- Effective pre-award assistance
- Effective award management assistance especially project finances

How can we build trust (in both directions) and strengthen PI support?



Human Subjects/IRB (beyond IRB; both pre- and post-award)






Example: **Project Finances** Drilldowns

Average Estimated Time Away Is Generally Lower with:

Preparation of fewer proposals


Although proposal preparation may have some scholarly value

(est. of ~39% prep time may have value),

proposal prep time is responsible for large amounts of (non-reimbursed) PI time away from research with low funding rates

How can proposal preparation dilemma be alleviated?







Which agency requirements are perceived as high priority for change to reduce admin burden?



Time Taken Away: Number of Funding Agencies



Average time away increases when PI must meet requirements of multiple different funding agencies.

How can we reduce redundancies, differences, and incompatibilities in requirements across agencies?






Are demographic differences associated with differences in estimated time away?

FWS Primary Themes

Higher perceived workload is associated with

- Public Inst./Lower R&D/Smaller average PI research time
- More training, curriculum, service projects
- Perceived lack of a culture of trust in Pls
- Perceived ineffective pre- and post-award assistance
- More animal and human subjects research
- Higher # of PI proposals
- Projects from more than one funding agency
- PI is Female, Hispanic, Black/Afr Amer
