Grants.gov Joint Application Design (JAD)

- Grants.gov Workspace Transition – Main Focus
- Feedback on user interface design and functionality
 - Participated in pilot testing
 - Functionality Spearheaded by JAD
 - Ability for institutions to grant AORs access to all workspaces
 - Ability to restrict budget and subaward budget access
 - Ability to grant workspace access to other institutions
- Institutional Preparedness
 - Assisted in defining target use cases (small and large institutional needs)
 - Trello Board for institutional use
 - Community announcement regarding PDF retirement (memo dated 12/19/2017)
 - Collaborated on revised website and categorized steps for use



DATA Act

- Completed work on the Federal DATA Act with FDP Open Government group
- Worked closely with DATA Act Grants PMO
- Participated in several DATA Act pilot tests
- Congress is contemplating additional legislation to streamline reporting – FDP will remain connected to these possible changes



Federal Agency Matrix

- Useful for FDP members to understand system requirements
- Federal agencies can see the number of systems that institutions must interact with
