

- January 28, 2019 –
 PAPPG becomes
 effective





PAPPG Significant Changes

- Use of Research.gov for proposal submission
 - Policy versus on-screen instructions
- Expands use of Dear Colleague Letters
 - RAPID, EAGER, RAISE & Conference Proposals
- International Branch Campuses of U.S. Institutions of Higher Education and Foreign Organizations
 - New checkbox on the proposal coversheet
 - Requirement to describe in the Project Description



PAPPG Significant Changes (cont'd)

- Eligibility for unaffiliated individuals has been revised to state that unless specifically authorized in an NSF solicitation (i.e., postdoctoral fellows), unaffiliated individuals are ineligible to receive direct funding from NSF
- Incorporates additional coverage highlighting NSF's policies on responsible conduct of research and research misconduct
- Synergistic Activities section of the biographical sketch is limited to five distinct examples only
- Participant Support enhancements
 - Speaker vs. Participant
 - Inclusion of answers to FAQs on this topic



PAPPG Significant Changes (cont'd)

- RAPID, EAGER and RAISE sections supplemented with reminders that these proposal types are not subject to reconsideration
- Conference proposals over \$50,000 and equipment proposals must include Collaborators and Other Affiliations information

 Resubmission section has been revised to establish that NSF programs that accept proposals at any time may have guidelines in which a declined proposal is ineligible to resubmit for a specified period of time



Changes to the PAPPG to Address Harassment

 New coverage has been added to the conference proposal section to require proposers to have a policy or code-of-conduct that addresses sexual and other forms of harassment and that includes clear and accessible means of reporting violations of the policy or code-of-conduct

 Change in PI coverage now has Changes in PI at the Initiation of the Grantee Organization, and adds a new section on Changes in PI at the Initiation of NSF
