

 - Number of annual financial disclosures ranging from 100
 11,000
- Nearly two thirds of institutions are impacted by state laws on COI
- Most institutions have electronic COI systems:
 - 16.5% indicated no electronic system
 - Nearly half indicated a "home-grown" system
 - About one third have a purchased system
