ezFedGrants is a grants management software system being developed for use throughout all of USDA.







ezFedGrants...

- Manages financial assistance activities, including grants
- Is fully integrated with USDA's general ledger (FMMI)
- Eliminates the need for double entry of financial data, reducing potential errors
- Will replace NIFA systems such as CREEMS, CDS, GAC, PRS, etc.





ezFedGrants is an Opportunity to:

- Standardize programmatic & financial processes
- Be more efficient/improve workflow
- Improve staff, grantee, & applicant experience
- Align with other USDA agencies
- Change & enhance the way we do business



Projected Timeline


- Dec. 2014 Mar. 2015:
