Broad Agency Announcement (BAA):

USAMRMC BAA FOR EXTRAMURAL MEDICAL RESEARCH

- Announcement No: W81XWH-BAA-15-1
 - Issued 10/1 of each year
 - Open and continuous for 1 year
 - Closes 9/30 of each year
 - Includes USAMRMC Areas of Interest

NEW for FY15:

- Pre-application is required
- Pre-application must be submitted through eBRAP
- Full application will only be accepted if the PI is invited to submit based on review of the pre-application



UPDATES TO FUNDING OPPORTUNITY ANNOUNCEMENTS



Program Specific BAAs and PROGRAM ANNOUNCEMENTS

NEW for FY15:

- Program Specific BAAs require pre-applications
- Program Announcements require Letters of Intent (LOIs) or preapplications
- LOIs and pre-applications <u>must</u> be submitted through eBRAP





What is eBRAP?

- electronic Biomedical Research Application Portal
- Managed by the Congressionally Directed Medical Research Program Office (CDMRP)
- Access eBRAP at:
 - https://ebrap.org/eBRAP/public/index.htm
- Old System: eReceipt being retired





- All LOIs and pre-applications must be submitted through eBRAP
- Registration process is <u>required</u> before you can submit a preapplication
 - ➤ PI must register and <u>associate</u> him/herself with a Business Official, or <u>invite</u> a Business Official
- Full applications are still submitted through Grants.gov
 - eBRAP pulls full applications from Grants.gov into system
- System includes a "verification" period for full applications during which you can make changes (usually a 5 calendar day period)
- Exception: Project Narrative and Budget must be resubmitted (before the deadline) through Grants.gov if changes are needed





- Summary Statements are posted
- "Invite" & "not invite" letters are posted
- Monitor when Letters of Recommendation have been submitted
- Regulatory documents can be uploaded
- Other requested documents can be uploaded
- Subscribe to Programs
